

About OC Connections

Enterprises



At OC Connections Enterprises people with disability can

- work
- and
- get the extra support they need.

This is called **supported employment**.



When you work in supported employment you can learn **skills** to help you get a job in **open employment**.

Why it is good to have a job?



Having a job can be good in lots of ways. It can

- help you feel good about yourself
 - help you feel part of a team
 - help you learn new **skills**
- and
- mean you have your own money to spend how you choose.

We will start by talking to you about your **goals**. Then we will make an employment plan together.

About our literacy and numeracy course



We have a **course** that can help you get better at

- reading and writing
- and
- maths.

These are also called **literacy** and **numeracy**.



The **course** is called a **Certificate 1 Transition to Education**.

About work experience



Work experience is when you try out a job to see what it is like. You can do work experience at OC Connections Enterprises.




Work experience helps you learn about

About work trials

You can do a **work trial** at OC Connections Enterprises. You can do this if you want to get a job with us.



A work trial is where you

- work for half a day
- try different **tasks**
- and
- meet other people who work there.



A work trial helps us understand your **goals**.



You do not get paid for the work trial.

How we work with you to find a job



If you choose OC Connections Enterprises we will work hard to find the right job for you.

We will

- talk to you about your work **goals**
- make a plan about how we can help you reach your **goals**.



We will meet with you once a year or more to see if your **goals** have changed.



We will ask you if you want to

- do something new
- or
- keep doing the thing you enjoy
- and
- if you need extra **training**.

Car washing is a good job because you can be


- active

<p>canteen</p>	<p>A place where you can buy food and drinks.</p> <p>A canteen is usually at a</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • school <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • place where people work.
<p>course</p>	<p>A set of classes you can do to learn about a subject. For example a literacy course is a set of classes where you learn about reading and writing.</p>
<p>community</p>	<p>The</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • people <p>and</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • places <p>around where you live.</p>

<p>Department of Defence</p>	<p>A part of the government that looks after the</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • army • navy and • airforce.
<p>filing</p>	<p>Putting paperwork away where it belongs.</p>
<p>forklift</p>	<p>A machine that is used to lift very heavy things.</p>
<p>goals</p>	<p>Things you want to do in your life</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • now and • in the future.
<p>open employment</p>	<p>A business that is not run by a disability support service provider.</p>
<p>photocopying</p>	<p>Making copies of paperwork using a machine called a photocopier.</p>

skills	To know how to do something well. For example if you have computer skills then you know how to use a computer well.
tasks	Jobs or things you have to do.
training	Learning how to do new things.
