QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

OC Connections considers candidates for disability support roles who are currently studying or who are qualified in the following areas: **Certificate III in Disability; Certificate IV in Disability; Certificate IV in Aged Care; Certificate III in Individual Support.**

Individuals applying for non-support roles will be required to have the necessary qualifications and experience suitable for the advertised role. These will be outlined in the position description.

WHAT IF YOU DO NOT HAVE QUALIFICATIONS?

You may be considered for employment without formal qualifications depending on your prior working experience.
